8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would amend the statute relating 9 to the State of Alabama Plumbers and Gas Fitters 10 Examining Board and the licensing and regulation of 11 plumbers and gas fitters.

12 This bill would provide further for 13 definitions; provide that unencumbered funds be transferred to the Alabama Home Builders Foundation 14 15 for classroom training; provide further for displaying business names and require master 16 17 plumbers and journeymen plumbers to have current 18 certification for installing, testing, or 19 maintaining backflow prevention devices; provide 20 further for renewal of certificates; provide for 21 reissuance fees for replacement certificates; provide for certain disciplinary actions by the 22 23 board; provide for posting of bonds by principal 24 master plumbers and gas fitters; provide further 25 for inactive status of certified plumbers and gas 26 fitters; provide further for exempted activities 27 and entities; and provide further for

administrative and disciplinary actions by the board.

Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama 3 4 of 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 5 Alabama of 1901, as amended, prohibits a general 6 7 law whose purpose or effect would be to require a new or increased expenditure of local funds from 8 becoming effective with regard to a local 9 10 governmental entity without enactment by a 2/3 vote 11 unless: it comes within one of a number of 12 specified exceptions; it is approved by the 13 affected entity; or the Legislature appropriates 14 funds, or provides a local source of revenue, to 15 the entity for the purpose.

The purpose or effect of this bill would be to require a new or increased expenditure of local funds within the meaning of the amendment. However, the bill does not require approval of a local governmental entity or enactment by a 2/3 vote to become effective because it comes within one of the specified exceptions contained in the amendment.

Sections 34-37-1, 34-37-2, 34-37-5, 23 34-37-6, 34-37-8, 34-37-9, 34-37-12, 34-37-13, 34-37-14, 24 25 34-37-15, and 34-37-17, Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

27 "§34-37-1. "For purposes of this chapter, the following terms
 shall have meanings respectively ascribed to them herein
 unless the context clearly requires a different meaning:

4 "(1) APPRENTICE GAS FITTER OR PLUMBER. A person other than a master or journeyman gas fitter or plumber, who 5 6 is engaged in learning and assisting in the installation of 7 gas pipe, equipment, apparatus, and appliances, and shall work directly under the supervision of a journeyman or master gas 8 fitter or plumber, and who has successfully fulfilled the 9 registration requirements of the board and has been duly 10 registered by the board as such for the current year. 11

12 "(2) BACKFLOW PREVENTION DEVICE. A device installed 13 within a water supply or a building distribution system on the 14 consumer side of the meter to protect the potable water supply 15 from contamination or cross connection.

16 "(2) (3) BOARD. The <u>State of</u> Alabama Plumbers and 17 Gas Fitters Examining Board as renamed by this chapter. The 18 board shall examine, certify, and regulate plumbers, gas 19 fitters, and medical gas piping fitters on a statewide basis 20 pursuant to this chapter.

"(3) (4) CERTIFICATION. The process of testing at the state level to determine the knowledge and skill of an individual with respect to plumbing and gas fitting, and the issuing of certificates to indicate that an individual has passed the examination.

26 "(4) (5) GAS FITTING, GAS SYSTEMS, or GAS WORK. The
 27 installation, repair of pipes, fixtures, fittings, appliances,

1 or apparatus necessary for supplying natural gas for 2 residential or commercial use from the point of delivery and all gas piping before connection to the combustion zone and 3 4 including the applicable venting of flue gases to the outside atmosphere and the provisions for air for combustion and 5 6 ventilation. This chapter shall not be construed to prevent 7 any contractor certified by the Alabama Board of Heating, and Air Conditioning, and Refrigeration Contractors from 8 installing, replacing, or performing service or repair on 9 natural gas fired air heating/cooling appliances, excluding 10 11 piping to them provided the installing contractor has a valid 12 certificate issued by the Alabama Board of Heating, and Air Conditioning, and Refrigeration Contractors. 13

14 "(5) (6) JOURNEYMAN GAS FITTER. A person who engages 15 in or works at the actual installation, repair, or replacement 16 of gas work, who has successfully fulfilled the examination 17 requirements of the board, has been issued a journeyman gas 18 fitter certificate by the board, and possesses a valid and 19 current annual certificate issued by the board. The 20 certificate shall be available for inspection on request.

"(6) (7) JOURNEYMAN PLUMBER. A person who engages in or works at the actual installation, repair, or replacement of plumbing systems, who has successfully fulfilled the examination requirements of the board, has been issued a journeyman plumber certificate by the board, and possesses a valid and current annual certificate issued by the board. The certificate shall be available for inspection on request.

A journeyman plumber or journeyman gas fitter whose certificate 19 bears an endorsement for installation of medical gas piping 20 21 shall be entitled to install medical gas piping under the 22 direction of a master plumber or master gas fitter whose 23 certificate entitles him or her to install medical gas piping. 24 The medical gas piping fitter shall have in his or her possession a current annual certificate with endorsement 25 26 issued by the board. The certificate shall be available for 27 inspection on request.

"(10) (11) MEDICAL GAS PIPING. Piping used solely to
 transport gases used for medical purposes.

3 "(11) (12) PLUMBING, PLUMBING SYSTEMS, or PLUMBING
4 WORK. The installation, repair, or replacement of pipes,
5 fixtures, or other apparatus necessary either for supplying
6 water or for removing liquid or waterborne waste. The term is
7 also used to denote installed fixtures, drainage, vents, and
8 water distribution systems.

9 "<u>(13) PRINCIPAL. The individual responsible for the</u> 10 <u>contracting, superintending, installation, maintenance, or</u> 11 <u>repair of plumbing and/or gas fitting systems for a business,</u> 12 <u>firm, or corporation, who is actively and continuously</u> 13 <u>connected with the conduct of the business and is solely</u> 14 <u>responsible to the board for the same.</u>

15 "(7) (14) PRINCIPAL MASTER GAS FITTER. Any person 16 engaged in or proposing to engage in the business of 17 contracting to do conduct, or of superintending the installation, maintenance, or repair of gas systems or gas 18 work, either or both. The individual shall qualify to be a 19 certified master gas fitter. If the business be a firm or 20 21 corporation, at least one active employee of the firm or 22 corporation shall be a duly registered and certified master 23 gas fitter, actively and continuously connected with the 24 conduct of the business and registered with the board as the 25 principal of the business and hold the required bond. The 26 master gas fitter shall have in his or her possession a

The individual shall qualify to be a certified master plumber. If the business is a 8 9 firm or corporation, at least one active employee of the firm 10 or corporation shall be a duly registered and certified master plumber, actively, continuously connected with the conduct of 11 12 the business and registered with the board as the principal of 13 the business and hold the required bond. The master plumber 14 shall have in his or her possession a current annual certificate issued by the board. The certificate shall be 15 available for inspection on request. 16

"The Plumbers Examining Board as created by Act No. 18 529 of the 1949 Regular Session of the Legislature (Acts 1949, 19 20 p. 827), as amended, is renamed the State of Alabama Plumbers 21 and Gas Fitters Examining Board and the authority of the board 22 is expanded to allow the board to examine, certify, and 23 regulate plumbers, gas fitters, and medical gas piping fitters 24 on a statewide basis. The board may make and enforce rules 25 adopted in accordance with Chapter 22 of Title 41, the Alabama Administrative Procedure Act. 26

1 "The board is authorized to expend funds for 2 purposes of public awareness of the board and its rules and 3 regulations to include advertising, promotional materials, 4 event exhibiting, or other means approved by the board.

"§34-37-5.

5

"(a) There is established a separate special revenue 6 7 trust fund in the State Treasury to be known as the State of Alabama Plumbers and Gas Fitters Examining Board Fund. All 8 receipts collected by the board under this chapter shall be 9 10 deposited in this fund and used only to carry out this 11 chapter. The fund shall be disbursed only by warrant of the 12 state Comptroller upon the State Treasury upon itemized 13 vouchers approved by the executive director of the board or, 14 in the absence of the executive director, by the deputy 15 director. No funds shall be withdrawn or expended except as budgeted and allotted according to Sections 41-4-80 to 16 17 41-4-96, inclusive, as amended, and only in amounts as stipulated in the general appropriation bill or other 18 appropriation bills. 4 "(b) The executive director and the deputy director of the board shall, before entering upon the duties of their 5 6 office, make and file with the Secretary of State an official 7 bond in the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000), unless covered by the state blanket bond. The appropriate premiums on 8 the bond shall be paid out of the funds of the board, and the 9 10 bond shall be executed by an approved bonding fidelity or quaranty company qualified to do business in Alabama and 11 12 acceptable to the Secretary of State.

11 "(1) An applicant for examination for a journeyman's 12 plumber or gas fitter certificate shall submit proof that the 13 applicant has two years of work experience as an apprentice 14 plumber or gas fitter or has completed an apprentice training 15 program approved by the board.

"(2) Applicants for journeyman plumber or gas fitter shall be examined, orally or in writing, upon the fundamentals of plumbing or gas fitting, the theory and practice of plumbing installation and construction or gas fitting work, and the experience and ability of the applicant in practical plumbing installation and construction or gas fitting work.

"<u>(3)</u> If the applicant is found to possess an accurate knowledge of the theory and correct practice of plumbing installation and construction or gas fitting work, and sufficient experience and ability in plumbing installation and construction or gas fitting work to safely and competently apply that knowledge and practice, the board shall issue a certificate, upon the applicant first paying all prescribed
 fees.

3 "(4) The examination shall may be administered by an
4 independent examining agency.

5 "(d) (e) The board shall examine and pass upon the 6 qualifications of every person who applies for a master's 7 plumber or gas fitter certificate upon forms provided by the 8 board.

9 "(1) Applicants for examination for a master plumber 10 certificate shall submit proof to the board that the applicant 11 has at least one year of work experience as a journeyman 12 plumber.

13 "(2) Applicants for examination for a master gas 14 fitter's certificate shall submit proof to the board that the 15 applicant has at least one year of work experience as a 16 journeyman gas fitter.

17 "(3) An applicant for a master's certificate shall 18 be examined upon knowledge, training, and ability, in the 19 planning, laying out, and supervision of plumbing installation 20 and construction work or gas fitting work, and if found to 21 possess those qualifications, the applicant shall be issued a 22 master's plumber or gas fitter certificate by the board <u>upon</u> 23 <u>the applicant first paying all prescribed fees</u>.

24 "<u>(4) The examination may be administered by an</u>
 25 <u>independent examining agency.</u>

26 "(e) (f) No person shall be issued a certificate
 27 without passing the prescribed examination. A person who has

1 passed the examination must become certified within 90 2 calendar days and shall not be required to take the examination thereafter in order to secure a certificate in 3 4 subsequent years. A person who passes the examination but fails to become certified shall be required to retake the 5 examination. At least four examinations per year shall be 6 7 conducted, at a time and place prescribed by the board after reasonable notice. 8

"(f) (g) Any master plumber, master gas fitter, 9 journeyman plumber, or journeyman gas fitter performing 10 medical gas piping shall provide proof to the board that he or 11 12 she has successfully completed a current medical gas piping 13 certification program approved by the board. The approval by 14 the board shall be indicated by endorsement as a medical gas 15 piping fitter on his or her certificate. Any journeyman performing medical gas piping shall work under the direction 16 17 of a master plumber or master gas fitter whose certificate entitles him or her to install medical gas piping. 18

20 shall be a United States citizen or, if not a citizen of the

"The board shall set the necessary fees to administer the requirements of this chapter and when adopted, such fee schedule shall be in lieu of any fee schedule heretofore prescribed by the board. The board shall not change the fee schedule to be effective in the middle of a calendar year.

"The certificates provided for herein shall be 8 9 issued by the board upon the payment of the prescribed fees. 10 All annual certificates shall expire on December 31 of the year in which they are issued. The certificate fees herein 11 12 prescribed shall be in addition to all privilege or license taxes otherwise levied. Certificates renewed after December 31 13 14 shall include the late renewal penalty established by the 15 board.

"All applicants requesting replacement of lost or
stolen certificates shall be required to pay a \$5 reissuance
fee based on the regular fee schedule.

"All persons serving in the armed forces will not be required to pay any back years for a renewal certificate during the calendar year he or she is released from active military duty. All other persons shall pay back years unless proof satisfactory to the board is furnished indicating that the individual was not employed in such years in the plumbing or gas fitting trade.

1 "The board may revoke or suspend any certificate if 2 obtained through concealment, misstatement, or misrepresentation of any material fact in the application for 3 4 such certificate, The board may discipline any certificate holder or for a willful violation of any law or ordinance 5 pertaining to the business of the holder of such certificates. 6 7 Before a certificate may be suspended or revoked, the holder thereof shall have notice in writing, enumerating the charges 8 9 against him or her, and be entitled to a hearing by the board not sooner than five days from receipt of notice. The holder 10 of such certificate shall be given an opportunity to present 11 12 testimony, oral or written, and right of cross-examination and 13 representation by counsel. All testimony shall be given under 14 oath. The board shall have power to administer oaths, issue 15 subpoenas, and compel the attendance of witnesses.

1 "Hearings shall be conducted by a hearing officer 2 appointed by the board. The hearing officer may be a board member, the executive director, or such other person as the 3 board may deem fit and proper to hold such hearing. The 4 5 testimony adduced at the hearing, along with all other proceedings, shall be taken down by a competent stenographer 6 7 and shall be preserved as a record of the board and shall be open to the public inspection at all reasonable times. 26 "In order to protect the public from damages arising27 from plumbing and gas fitting or plumbing work and gas fitting

1 work failing to comply with the requirements of any state laws 2 applicable thereto, or with the ordinances of any municipal corporation applicable thereto, it is hereby provided that 3 4 before any person engages in the business of principal master plumber or principal master gas fitter, he or she shall 5 6 execute and deposit with the judge of probate in the county of 7 his or her principal place of business board a bond in the sum of \$2,000 fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000). Such bond shall 8 9 be a cash bond of \$2,000 or executed by a surety authorized 10 and qualified to write surety bonds in the State of Alabama $_{\overline{t}}$ and shall be approved by the probate judge. Such bond shall be 11 12 conditioned upon all plumbing and gas fitting work done 13 performed or supervised by such principal master plumber or 14 principal master gas fitter complying with the provisions of 15 any laws or ordinances relating to plumbing and gas fitting and applicable thereto. 4 "(a) No person who has obtained a certificate shall allow his or her name to be used by another person, either for 5 the purpose of obtaining permits, or doing business or work 6 7 under his or her certificate; and every person certified shall notify the board of the address of his or her place of 8 business and the name under which such business is carried on, 9 10 and shall give immediate notice to the board of any change in 11 either.

12 "(b) Before any person certified by the board 13 engages in the business of master plumber and/or master gas 14 fitter, he or she shall notify the board of the address of the 15 place of business he or she engages in as such and the name under which such business is carried on and shall give 16 17 immediate notice of any change in either. All information required by this section shall be furnished on a business 18 certification form furnished by the board. 19

"(c) Any certified master plumber or master gas 20 21 fitter who desires to renew his or her annual certificate but does not intend to engage as a master, as defined in this 22 23 chapter, shall complete an inactive status affidavit obtained 24 from the board and shall remit the annual renewal fee set in 25 the fee schedule. Code officials who hold a certification with 26 the board and wish to be inactive shall be exempt from all 27 renewal fees and examination requirements.

"(a) The following acts, work, and conduct may be performed by anyone, without license or <u>a</u> certificate, provided, however, that all work and services herein named or referred to shall be subject to an inspection and approval in accordance with the terms of all state laws and applicable municipal ordinances:

"(1) Plumbing Gas fitting work done performed by 8 9 anyone who is regularly employed or and acting as a 10 maintenance man acting under the supervision of a maintenance 11 engineer or maintenance engineer incidental to and in 12 connection with the business in which he or she is employed 13 and engaged, provided the gas fitting work is done performed 14 on the premises of the employer, and who does not engage in 15 the occupation of a plumber or gas fitter for the general 16 public.

17 "(2) Maintenance and reinstallation Plumbing work 18 done performed upon the premises or equipment of a railroad, 19 or other businesses or industry, by an employee thereof who 20 does not engage in the occupation of a plumber or gas fitter 21 for the general public.

"(3) Plumbing or gas fitting work done performed by persons engaged by <u>or employed by</u> any public utility company in the laying, maintenance, and operation of its service mains or lines and the installation, alteration, adjustment, repair, removal, and renovation of all types of appurtenances, <u>and</u> equipment, <u>and appliances</u>, provided such plumbing work does not necessitate tying into waste or sewer lines on the outlet side of a trap or alter gas piping on <u>the</u> consumer side of meter.

4 "(4) Appliances or fixture installations and service
5 work done in connecting appliances or fixtures to existing
6 piping installations.

7 "(4) Plumbing work performed by a property owner in
8 or about a building owned or occupied by the owner.

9 "(b) Any person may install washing machines to 10 existing piping installation or waste lines, provided such 11 plumbing work does not necessitate tying into waste or sewer 12 lines on the outlet side of the trap.

"(c) This chapter shall not apply to any natural gas
 utility company having fewer than 350 employees that is
 regulated by the Alabama Public Service Commission.

16 "(d) (c) This chapter does not apply to any plumbing 17 work done by a property owner in or about a building owned or occupied by him or her, or plumbing work done by anyone who is 18 regularly employed by the property owner to provide 19 maintenance or other repair services if the work is incidental 20 21 to and in connection with the property for which he or she is 22 employed and engaged and is done on the premises of the 23 employer.

25 "(a) The board shall have the administrative
 26 authority to discipline or require a certificate holder to
 27 attend training specific to violations. The board has the

authority to levy civil fines or penalties to any certificate
holder for a violation of any provision of this chapter
regulating plumbers, gas fitters, or medical gas fitters up to
two thousand dollars (\$2,000) and actual costs of hearing the
revocation.
(b) In addition to or in lieu of the criminal
penalties and administrative sanctions provided in this

8 <u>chapter, the board may issue an order to any person, firm, or</u> 9 <u>corporation engaged in any activity, conduct, or practice</u> 10 <u>constituting a violation of this chapter, directing the</u> 11 <u>person, firm, or corporation to forthwith cease and desist</u> 12 <u>from the activity, conduct, practice, or performance of any</u> 13 <u>work then being performed or about to be commenced.</u>

14 "(c) It shall be unlawful for any person to violate 15 any provision of this chapter regulating plumbers, gas 16 fitters, or medical gas piping fitters. Any person convicted 17 of such violation shall be punished as prescribed for a Class 18 B <u>A</u> misdemeanor."

19 Section 2. Although this bill would have as its purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased 20 21 expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements and application under Amendment 621, now 22 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of 23 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the 24 bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an 25 26 existing crime.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
 first day of the third month following its passage and
 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
