follows: Fifty percent to the county general fund and 50 percent in county debt reduction fund.

Section 2. Any county business license pursuant to this act shall be issued and the fee collected by the judge of probate for businesses outside of the corporate limits of a municipality. All municipalities in the county shall issue and collect the fees for the business licenses inside of the corporate limits of a municipality. Perry County shall pay each municipality a ten dollar (\$10) issuance fee for each business license issued by a municipality.

Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.

Section 4. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
