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4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Relating to motor vehicle registrations; to allow a
6 county official authorized to issue motor vehicle
7 registrations to offer an optional two-year registration for
8 motor vehicles operated on the public highways of this state;
9 to specify the payment of local issuance fees, license taxes
10 and registration fees, and ad valorem taxes.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, the
13 county commission, in consultation with the local judge of
14 probate or other county license plate issuing official
15 authorized to issue motor vehicle registrations may authorize
16 an optional two-year registration renewal for motor vehicles
17 operated on the public highways of this state.

18 (b) If a registrant elects to renew his or her motor
19 registration for a two-year period, he or she shall do all of
20 the following:

21 (1) Pay the local issuance fee. The registrant shall
22 not be required to pay an additional local issuance fee for
23 the second year of registration.

1 (2) Pay the license taxes, ad valorem tax, and
2 registration fees for each year at the time of the election to
3 renew the registration for two years.

4 Section 2. This act shall become effective on
5 January 1, 2015, following its passage and approval by the
6 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
