20	Section 1. (a) The driver's license of a resident of
21	this state who has been medically diagnosed with autism
22	spectrum disorder, upon request of the resident, shall have
23	the letters "ASD" displayed on his or her driver's license.
24	(b) The Director of Public Safety shall establish by
25	rule the proof required to be produced by a person with autism
26	spectrum disorder who requests that the "ASD" designation be
27	placed upon his or her driver's license. Except as provided in

- subsection (a), the contents of the license of a person with autism spectrum disorder shall be the same as for any other license.
- 4 (c) The Department of Public Safety may not impose
  5 any charge in addition to the driver's license fee for placing
  6 the "ASD" designation upon the driver's license of a person
  7 with autism spectrum disorder.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
