Section 1. PAY BONUS, FY 2014-2015. (a) The State Budget Officer shall allocate to the State Board of Education, the Board of Trustees of the Alabama Institute for Deaf and Blind, the Board of Youth Services School District, the Board

establish miscellaneous pay provisions relating to public

of Directors of the Alabama School of Fine Arts, and the Board of Trustees of the Alabama School of Mathematics and Science and for disbursement to the employees thereof funds based on the criteria established in this act. It is not the intent of this act to make appropriations, but the appropriations required by this act shall be made in the annual Education Trust Fund budget act for the designated fiscal year.

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(1) Certificated Personnel (K-12). For the 2014-2015 fiscal year only, each certificated employee at all city and county school systems and the teachers at the Department of Youth Services School District shall receive a one percent bonus in a lump sum on December 1, 2014. All certificated employees shall be guaranteed the bonus which shall be equal to one percent of their salary according to their placement on the appropriate salary step on the State Minimum Salary Schedule contained in the annual budget act for the public schools for fiscal year 2014-2015. The provisions and requirements of this act shall be in addition to the provisions of Section 16-13-231.1, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the State Minimum Salary Schedule which provides that each certificated employee shall be properly placed on the local salary schedule according to degree earned and years of public education service (either in-state or out-of-state), which shall be not less than the amounts appropriated for the State Minimum Salary Schedule. The employee shall be paid according to degree earned and length of public education experience. The one-time lump sum bonus provided by this act

1 shall be given to each person employed for the 2014-2015 fiscal year only in addition to any state or local step increase to which the employee is otherwise entitled. The 3 local board of education shall transmit to the State Department of Education the appropriate notice of the earned 6 advanced degree for each employee in a timely fashion; 7 thereafter, the employee shall be paid for the advanced degree as soon as the degree is certified to the State Department of 9 Education as being earned.

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- (2) Education Support Personnel (K-12). For the 2014-2015 fiscal year, a one percent lump sum bonus shall be paid to each public education support worker and adult bus driver employed full-time on December 1, 2014 for the 2014-2015 fiscal year only in addition to the salary received during the 2013-2014 fiscal year, except employees covered under the state's Merit System at the Department of Youth Services District. Each governing body or authority shall establish and maintain a salary schedule for each class and type of employee. The base rate of pay for part-time support employees shall be increased by one percent for fiscal year 2014-2015 only. A separate local salary schedule shall be established and maintained for each specific job performed.
- (3) AIDB. For the fiscal year 2014-2015 only, certificated and full-time support employees at the Alabama Institute for Deaf and Blind shall receive a one percent bonus in a lump sum on December 1, 2014. The bonus provided in this act shall be in excess of the salaries received during the

2 2013-2014 fiscal year. The base rate of pay for part-time 2 support employees shall be increased by one percent for the 3 2014-2015 fiscal year only.

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- c. Miscellaneous Requirements. The AIDB board shall establish and maintain a salary schedule for each class and type of employee. The bonus contained in this subsection shall be paid to each employee.
- (4) Two-Year Postsecondary Institutions. For the fiscal year 2014-2015 only, a one percent bonus in a lump sum shall be given to each person employed by the two-year postsecondary institutions in addition to any step increase to which the employee is otherwise entitled. The amount of the bonus shall be equal to one percent of their salaries as indicated in salary schedules established by the State Board of Education and shall be paid on December 1, 2014. The Postsecondary Education Department shall take proper steps to ensure that employees on all salary schedules are given full credit for prior work experience in the public schools and colleges, and shall take care to ensure proper placements on the salary schedules. Placement on the revised salary schedules shall be in accordance with the employee's length of service in public education. No bonus shall be given to any two-year postsecondary employee in excess of one percent, except as specifically provided in this act.
- (5) Miscellaneous provisions. The following provisions are hereby established:

a. Fiscal Year. All salaries and salary increases which are established by the State Board of Education shall be paid in full to each person employed before the end of the applicable fiscal year as defined in Section 16-1-1 of the Code of Alabama 1975, as amended.

- b. Extended Work. Public K-12 school employees on contracts which extend beyond 187 days, or the hourly equivalent thereof, shall be given a pro rata salary increment for each or partial day of work extending beyond 187 days.
- c. Local Increment. The one-time lump sum bonus provided in this act for teachers shall be exclusive of any local pay increase granted or due to teachers under provisions of any local salary schedule. The one-time lump sum bonus required by this act for public school support personnel shall be in addition to any pay increase due or granted to the employee under provisions of any local salary schedules. The bonus provisions of this act shall not apply to any salary supplements granted by local boards of education, bonuses earned for certification by the National Board of Professional Teaching Standards, or the federal portion of the salary paid to a Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) instructor employed by a local school board.
- d. Community Education. Each county and city board of education shall have the option to exclude from the provisions of this act any part-time employees of community education or school-sponsored child care or child enrichment

- program which is supplemental to the state-required educational program.
- e. Local Chief Executive Officers. The bonus

  provisions of this act shall not apply to superintendents of

  education of any school system or institution. Any bonus given

  to the superintendent shall be by majority recorded vote of

  the governing body or authority.
- Section 2. The one-time lump sum bonus granted in
  this act is for fiscal year 2014-2015 only. Nothing in this
  act shall authorize this bonus increase or any other
  additional pay increases in subsequent years.
- Section 3. The provisions of this act are severable.

  If any part of this act is declared invalid or

  unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part

  which remains.
- Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
