22	court clerk.	
23	(b) To defray the expense of establishing and	
24	maintaining electronic citations, the court clerk in the	
25	circuit, district, or municipal court shall charge and collect	
26	an electronic citation fee of six dollars (\$6) as court costs	

in any traffic, misdemeanor, municipal ordinance, or

conservation case. This fee shall be in addition to all other
court costs and shall be disbursed as provided in this
section. Sixty percent of the fee shall be retained by the
court clerk collecting the fee and 40 percent of the fee shall
be disbursed to the state, county, or municipal fund funding
the arresting law enforcement agency. All of the proceeds
shall be used solely to defray expenses related to the
establishment and maintenance of electronic citations.

(c) The court clerk shall charge and collect an electronic citation fee if the county commission or municipal governing body by ordinance elects to be subject to this section.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
