15 "(a) All persons shall have the right to hunt and 16 fish in this state in accordance with law and regulations. The 17 people have a right to hunt, fish, and harvest wildlife, including by the use of traditional methods, subject to 18 reasonable regulations, to promote wildlife conservation and 19 management, and to preserve the future of hunting and fishing. 20 21 Public hunting and fishing shall be the preferred means of 22 managing and controlling wildlife. This amendment shall not be 23 construed to modify any provision of law relating to eminent 24 domain, trespass, or property rights. 25 "(b) This amendment shall be known as the

26 "Sportsperson's Bill of Rights.""

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:
