BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) The Legislature finds that the State Board of Education, in the fall of 2013, voted to rescind the Memorandum of Agreement that involved the State of Alabama in adopting the common core curriculum standards and declared that the collection of personal data concerning students of Alabama public schools would not be collected or compiled.

- (b) In order to codify the intent of the board, the State of Alabama hereby terminates all plans, programs, activities, efforts, and expenditures relative to the implementation of the educational initiative commonly referred to as the to Common Core State Educational Standards, or any derivative or permutation thereof, including but not limited to, the Alabama College and Career Standards which have been adopted or may be adopted by the board or its employees, including any assessments, data collection, and instructions based on or involving any such standard or protocol.
- (c) Any citizen of the State of Alabama shall have standing in the courts of Alabama to bring suit to ensure the enforcement of this section.
- (d) The board shall replace the current common core curriculum standards with the courses of study in place

- immediately prior to adoption of the common core curriculum
 standards.
- (e) On January 1, 2017, the courses of study
 described in subsection (d) may be updated in accordance with
 state law.
- Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
