25	Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of
26	law, for purposes of all local ONE SPOT collection of sales,
27	use, and rental taxes, the taxes shall be due and payable on

- or before the 20th day of the month next succeeding the month in which the tax accrues.
- Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
