			LEGISLATURE	

Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, the term "adopted child" means an individual under the age of 19 years who has been adopted under the laws of this state or another jurisdiction.

- (b) Unless otherwise permitted by law, a biological parent may not contact, or attempt to contact, by any means, an adopted child unless the adoptive parent has consented to the contact in writing.
- (c) Upon a violation of subsection (b) by a biological parent, the adoptive parent may seek a restraining order pursuant to the laws of this state to prohibit the biological parent from contacting, or attempting to contact, the adopted child.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
