26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Ι	Section 1. Section 22-18-5, Code of Alabama 1975, is
2	amended to read as follows:

4	"(a) There shall be an advisory board <del>of 25 members</del>
5	to assist in the establishment of rules, regulations and
6	standards necessary to carry out the provisions of this
7	article. The board shall meet at least <del>once</del> <u>twice</u> each year
8	and at the call of the State Health Officer. The State Health
9	Officer shall be an ex officio member of the advisory board.
10	The advisory board shall elect one from its membership to
11	serve as chair for a two-year term. The chair shall not serve
12	consecutive terms.
13	"(b) Composition of the advisory board shall be:
14	"(1) One member, who shall be a paramedic,
15	designated by the Alabama Ambulance Association Association of
16	Ambulance Services.
17	"(2) One member, who shall be a paramedic,
18	designated by the Alabama Association of Rescue Squads.
19	"(3) One member, who shall be a paramedic or a
20	physician, designated by the Alabama Hospital Association.

22	four years or until his or her successor is appointed,
23	whichever is sooner.
24	"(d) Each ex officio member's term will be
25	indefinite. In the case of vacancy, the new appointee shall
26	serve for the remainder of the unexpired term. Any vacancy
27	shall be filled by the original organization selecting said

member. Members of the advisory board shall serve without
compensation but shall be entitled to reimbursement for
expenses incurred in the performance of the duties of their
office as provided in Article 2 of Chapter 7 of Title 36 of
this code.

"(e) With the consent of the majority of the members of the advisory board, the chair shall set requirements for proxy representation, voting, and the establishment of a quorum."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
