14	Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any other laws, any
15	active and contributing member of the Employees' Retirement
16	System of Alabama may purchase up to two years of service
17	credit for the time he or she was receiving benefits pursuant
18	to the Alabama Workers' Compensation Act, commencing with
19	Section 25-5-1, Code of Alabama 1975, and was absent from work
20	due to a work related and compensable injury; provided that
21	the member returned to work with his or her covered employer
22	within one year following cessation of workers' compensation
23	benefits. The Board of Control of the Employees' Retirement
24	System shall adopt rules and regulations for the
25	administration of this section including verification of the
26	service that the member desires to purchase credit for in the
27	system. The member shall receive credit for the service when

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he or she remits to the system the contributions required by subsection (b). Notwithstanding the foregoing language, no member of the Employees' Retirement System shall be eligible to receive credit for any period of time that the member is already credited with in the system or in any other retirement plan, with the exception of the federal Social Security program.

8 (b) Any member who is eligible to purchase service 9 credit in the Employees' Retirement System under subsection 10 (a) shall pay to the Secretary-Treasurer of the system within 11 two years from the end of the disability period for which 12 credit is sought for the claimed service, a lump sum equal to 13 the full actuarially required cost for each year of service 14 credit purchased as determined by the actuary for the system.

15 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 16 first day of the third month following its passage and 17 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
