2 To amend Section 34-25-22, Code of Alabama 1975, relating to applications for licensure as a polygraph 3 4 examiner; to additionally require an applicant to provide two sets of fingerprints to the Board of Polygraph Examiners to 5 6 forward to the Alabama Bureau of Investigation for a state and 7 national background check of the applicant; to require an applicant to give written consent to release the results of 8 9 the background checks to the Board of Polygraph Examiners; and 10 to require the applicant to bear the costs of the background 11 checks. 12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 13 Section 1. Section 34-25-22, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows: 14 "§34-25-22. 15 "(a) Applications for original license shall be made 16 17 to the board in writing under oath on forms prescribed by the board and shall be accompanied by the required fee, which is 18 not refundable. Any such application shall require such 19 information as in the judgment of the board will enable it to 20 21 pass on the qualifications of the applicant for a license. 22 "(b) An applicant shall provide the board with two 23 complete sets of fingerprints to be sent to the Alabama Bureau 24 of Investigation to conduct a criminal history background 25 check.
