A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT
Relating to certain utility services, to allow for
the collection of attorney fees for the collection of debts.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
Section 1. (a) Utility services including gas,
electric power and light, and water services may retain a
licensed attorney for the purpose of collecting debts owed by
any person.
(b) The utility service may add a reasonable fee,
payable by the debtor, to the outstanding debt for the
collection fee incurred or to be incurred.
(c) This bill is not applicable to companies
providing cable TV or Internet services.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
first day of the third month following its passage and
approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
