The amendment provides that 21 lottery proceeds will not supplant or replace existing education revenues, establishes the 22 Lottery Trust Fund, and authorizes the Legislature 23 24 to pass general laws to implement the amendment. 25 26 A BILL 27 TO BE ENTITLED

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
15	Section 1. The following amendment to the
16	Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and
17	shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a
18	majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in
19	accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution
20	of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284, 285 and 287
21	of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama
22	of 1901, as amended:
23	PROPOSED AMENDMENT
24	Section 65 of Article IV of the Constitution of
25	Alabama of 1901, as amended, is amended to read as follows:
26	"Section 65.
27	" <u>part i.</u>

1	"The Except as provided in Part II of this section,
2	the Legislature shall have no power to authorize lotteries or
3	gift enterprises for any purposes, and shall pass laws to
4	prohibit the sale in this state of lottery or gift enterprise
5	tickets, or tickets in any scheme in the nature of a lottery;
6	and all acts, or parts of acts heretofore passed by the
7	Legislature of this state, authorizing a lottery or lotteries,
8	and all acts amendatory thereof, or supplemental thereto, are
9	hereby avoided.
10	" <u>PART II.</u>
11	" <u>(a) Establishment of an Alabama Lottery.</u>
12	"The Legislature shall, by general law, provide for
13	the establishment, administration, operation, and regulation
14	<u>of an Alabama Lottery.</u>
15	"(b) Replacement of Existing Education Funds
16	Prohibited.
17	"Funds deposited into the Education Trust Fund which
18	are derived from the Alabama Lottery shall not replace or
19	supplant existing or any other funds dedicated or intended for
20	the purposes of such Fund.
21	" <u>(c) Lottery Trust Fund.</u>
22	"The proceeds from the Alabama Lottery shall be
23	applied first to the payment of the expenses of administering
24	and operating the Alabama Lottery, including, without
25	limitation, the payment of all prizes, without any further
26	appropriation required by law, and the balance of such
27	proceeds remaining after such payments shall be deposited, as

1	provided by general law, and held in a special, separate
2	account in the State Treasury hereby created and designated
3	the "Lottery Trust Fund" until such time as such proceeds are
4	disbursed pursuant to this amendment.
5	"(d) Alabama Lottery Corporation.
6	"The administration of the Alabama Lottery shall be
7	vested in a corporation hereby created and designated the
8	"Alabama Lottery Corporation." The duties, powers, authority,
9	and composition of the Alabama Lottery Corporation shall be
10	provided by general law.
11	"(e) Allocations and Disbursements.
12	" <u>(1) Monies in the Lottery Trust Fund shall be</u>
13	allocated and disbursed to the Education Trust Fund to be used
14	exclusively (a) first, to increase the annual appropriation
15	for classroom instructional supplies to \$1,000 per teacher
16	unit; (b) a minimum of \$25 million annually to help local
17	public school systems hire, train and equip resource officers
18	to place in the local schools; and (c) the remainder to
19	provide scholarships to citizens of Alabama who are A/B Honor
20	Roll students, as established by the Legislature, to attend
21	universities, colleges, and junior, technical, or community
22	colleges located in Alabama.
23	"(f) Agreements with other Jurisdictions.
24	"The Alabama Lottery Corporation may enter into
25	reciprocal agreements with other jurisdictions for the
26	operation and promotion of games which are permitted to be
27	operated, utilized, or conducted by the Alabama Lottery.

1	"(g) Limitation on activities.
2	"The Alabama Lottery may authorize, conduct, employ,
3	include, or utilize only those games of chance approved by the
4	Alabama Lottery Corporation which may include, without
5	limitation, the sale of lottery tickets; provided, however,
6	that the Alabama Lottery is prohibited from operating, using,
7	or employing, or authorizing the operation, use, or employment
8	of, directly or indirectly, a casino or casinos and is further
9	prohibited from authorizing, conducting, employing, including,
10	or utilizing, directly or indirectly, any form of casino
11	gambling.
12	"(h) Implementation.
13	"The Legislature may enforce and implement this
14	section by appropriate general law. Any act or acts that are
15	enacted by the Alabama Legislature during the same session of
16	the Legislature at which this amendment is proposed and which
17	are in implementation and furtherance of the purposes of this
18	amendment and the authority granted by this amendment, and all
19	actions heretofore taken pursuant to such act or acts, are
20	hereby validated, ratified, and confirmed as effective as of
21	the date on which such act or acts were so enacted in
22	accordance with the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as
23	amended, and as of the respective dates on which such actions
24	were taken.
25	"(i) Nothing in this amendment affects, prohibits,
26	or limits any activity which was legal at the time this
27	amendment becomes effective including, without limitation,

pari-mutuel betting and nonprofit bingo as provided for by specific laws.

3 "(i) The terms and provisions of this amendment and 4 of any enabling legislation enacted by the Alabama Legislature 5 with respect to this amendment shall supersede and take 6 precedence over any other provision of law which may conflict 7 or be inconsistent with this amendment or such legislation, 8 and this amendment and such enabling legislation shall operate 9 and be construed without regard to such conflict or

10 <u>inconsistency.</u>"

11 Section 2. An election upon the above proposed 12 amendment shall be held, in accordance with the provisions of Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, 13 now appearing as Sections 284 and 285 of the Official 14 15 Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the general election laws of Alabama. Notice of 16 17 the election and of the proposed amendment shall be given by proclamation of the Governor, which proclamation shall be 18 published once a week for four successive weeks next preceding 19 20 the day appointed for the election in a newspaper in each 21 county of the state.

22 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 23 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 24 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 25 following description on the proposed constitutional 26 amendment:

"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 1 2 Alabama of 1901, to establish an Alabama Lottery and an Alabama Lottery Trust Fund, to distribute net lottery proceeds 3 to the Education Trust Fund for classroom instructional 4 supplies, and resource officers and scholarships; to create an 5 Alabama Lottery Corporation to regulate and administer the 6 7 lottery; to prohibit the operation of casinos; to require the proceeds to be used to increase funding for education and not 8 to take the place of existing education revenues; and to allow 9 10 the Legislature to implement the Alabama Lottery through 11 appropriate general law."

12 This description shall be followed by the following 13 language:
