1 To exempt the East Alabama Regional Planning and 2 Development Commission from the payment of all state, county, 3 and municipal sales and use taxes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

5 Section 1. The East Alabama Regional Planning and 6 Development Commission is exempted from paying or collecting 7 any state, county, and municipal sales and use taxes.

8 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 9 first day of the third month following its passage and 10 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
