1 participate in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama
2 upon the same terms and conditions as may be specified by law
3 for any other employee in the same retirement system, and
4 shall be treated as an employee of the county. Cullman County
5 officials or sheriff holding office at the time of the
6 ratification of this amendment shall be eligible to purchase
7 service credit in the Employees' Retirement System for the
8 time the official has served in the current office. No person
9 may participate in both a supernumerary program and the
10 Employees' Retirement System based on the same service. For
11 the purposes of this amendment, the words "elected or
12 appointed Cullman County official" shall include any person
13 appointed to serve the remaining term of an elected or
14 appointed Cullman County official. The words do not include a
15 judge, county commissioner, district attorney, legislator,
16 constable, school board member, or any official elected from a
17 judicial circuit.

18 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
19 shall be held at the 2014 General Election in accordance with
20 Amendment 555 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now
21 appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of
22 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the
23 election laws of this state.

24 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
25 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
26 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the

1 following description of the substance or subject matter of
2 the proposed constitutional amendment:

3 "Relating to Cullman County, proposing an amendment
4 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to phase out the
5 supernumerary system for certain public officials and allow
6 elected or appointed county officials, as defined, to
7 participate in the Employees' Retirement System.

8 "Proposed by Act _____"

9 This description shall be followed by the following
10 language:
