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2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 To authorize the governing body of the City of
4 Auburn, Alabama, pursuant to Amendment 373 to the Constitution
5 of Alabama of 1901, to increase the rate at which there is
6 levied and collected by the city, on all taxable property
7 situated within the city, the special ad valorem tax for the
8 support and furtherance of education which is authorized in
9 Amendment 148 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to a
10 rate, for any tax year of the city, which is equal to \$1.40 on
11 each one hundred dollars (14 mills on each dollar) of assessed
12 value.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

14 Section 1. The following words and phrases shall
15 have the following meanings:

16 (1) AMENDMENT 148. That amendment to the
17 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, that was proposed by Act No.
18 31, S. 56, 1959 Regular Session.

19 (2) AMENDMENT 373. That amendment to the
20 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, that was proposed by Act No.
21 6, H. 170, 1978 Second Special Session.

22 (3) CITY. Auburn, Alabama.

23 (4) CONSTITUTION. The Constitution of Alabama of
24 1901.

25 (5) COUNCIL. Auburn City Council.

1 (6) SPECIAL SCHOOL TAX. The special ad valorem tax
2 for the support and furtherance of education authorized in
3 Amendment 148 and elections held in the city on May 16, 1960,
4 May 25, 1965, November 25, 1986, and October 23, 2001, to be
5 levied and collected, without limit as to time, on taxable
6 property in the city.

7 Section 2. The city presently levies and collects
8 the special school tax at a rate of fifty cents (\$.50) on each
9 one hundred dollars (\$100) (5 mills on each dollar) of
10 assessed value pursuant to Amendment 148. Pursuant to a
11 resolution adopted by the council in accordance with Amendment
12 373, the city proposes to increase the rate at which it may
13 levy and collect the special school tax to a rate, for any tax
14 year, which is equal to one dollar and forty cents (\$1.40) on
15 each one hundred dollars (\$100) (14 mills on each dollar) of
16 assessed value.

17 Section 3. Pursuant to subsection (f) of Amendment
18 373 and a resolution adopted by the council after a public
19 hearing, the council may increase the rate at which the city
20 levies and collects the special school tax to a rate, for any
21 tax year, which is equal to one dollar and forty cents (\$1.40)
22 on each one hundred dollars (\$100) (14 mills on each dollar)
23 of assessed value.

24 Section 4. The increase in the rate at which the
25 special school tax may be levied and collected pursuant to

1 this act is subject to the approval of a majority of the
2 qualified electors residing in the city who vote on the
3 proposed increase at a special election called and held for
4 such purpose pursuant to the provisions of subsection (f) of
5 Amendment 373.

6 Section 5. This act shall become effective
7 immediately following its passage and approval by the
8 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
