14	vacancies, from at least 14 to at least seven school days
15	before the position is to be filled.
16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
17	Section 1. Section 16-22-15 of the Code of Alabama
18	1975, is amended to read as follows:
19	"§16-22-15.
20	"(a) For the purposes of this section, the following
21	words shall have the following meanings:
22	"(1) BOARD OF EDUCATION or BOARD. All public county
23	and city boards of education; the Board of Trustees of the
24	Alabama Institute for Deaf and Blind; the Alabama Youth
25	Services Department School Board in its capacity as the Board
26	of Education for the Youth Services School District; the Board
27	of Directors of the Alabama School of Fine Arts; the Board of

Trustees of the Alabama High School of Mathematics and
 Science; and the State Board of Education as applied to
 two-year postsecondary education institutions.

4 "(2) EXECUTIVE OFFICER. The superintendent of any public county or city school system; the President of the 5 6 Alabama Institute for Deaf and Blind; the president of any 7 two-year school or college under the auspices of the State Board of Education: the Executive Director of the Alabama 8 School of Fine Arts; the Superintendent of the Department of 9 10 Youth Services School District; and the Executive Director of the Alabama High School of Mathematics and Science. 11

12 "(3) EMPLOYEES. Employees or personnel of the board13 except for the following:

14 "a. Those employees covered under the Alabama state15 Merit System.

16 "b. Those employees of the Alabama Institute for
17 Deaf and Blind who work for the Alabama Industries for the
18 Blind and those satellite employees at its regional centers.

19 "(b) Each board of education, through its executive 20 officer, shall post a notice of vacancy for each vacant 21 personnel position. The notice shall be posted in a 22 conspicuous place at each school campus and worksite at least 23 14 calendar days before the position is to be filled. The 24 notice shall include, but not necessarily be limited to, all 25 of the following:

26 "(1) Job description and title.

27 "(2) Required qualifications.

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- "(3) Salary schedule and amount.

2 "(4) Information on where to submit an application.

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"(5) Information on any deadlines for applying.

"(6) Any other relevant information.

5 "(c) If a personnel vacancy occurs during the time 6 when the schools are in session, the vacancy notice shall be 7 posted not less than seven three calendar school days before 8 the position is to be filled. All vacancies involving jobs 9 which are supervisory, managerial, or otherwise newly created 10 positions shall nevertheless require posting notices of at 11 least 14 seven calendar school days.

12 "(d) The board may adopt or continue policies which 13 are not inconsistent with this section. The board may adopt 14 policies to ensure the safety and welfare of its students 15 during dire emergency situations, but the posting of a vacancy notice as required in this section shall not be abridged or 16 17 delayed except in dire emergency circumstances and then delayed only temporarily in order to reasonably meet the 18 conditions of the emergency. The adoption of additional 19 policies shall comply with the requirements and procedures of 20 21 Section 16-1-30 by all boards defined in this section."

22 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 23 first day of the third month following its passage and 24 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
