15 AN ACT

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17 Relating to health insurance; to prohibit the
18 conditioning of licensing of certain health care providers on
19 participation in health insurance plans and other activities.
20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

21 Section 1. (a) State licensure requirements for
22 physicians and dentists in this state shall be granted based
23 on demonstrated skill and academic competence. Licensure
24 approval for physicians and dentists in this state may not be
25 conditioned upon or related to participation in any public or
26 private health insurance plan, public health care system,
27 public service initiative, or emergency room coverage.

1 (b) The licensure of dentists, osteopaths, and
2 physicians shall be conducted exclusively pursuant to Chapter
3 9 of Title 34; Division 1, commencing with Section 34-24-50,
4 of Article 3 of Chapter 24 of Title 34; and Division 1,
5 commencing with Section 34-24-310, of Article 8 of Title 34,
6 respectively, Code of Alabama 1975.

7 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
8 first day of the third month following its passage and
9 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
