Relating to Cullman County; to provide for
contracting of police services by a municipality with the
Sheriff of Cullman County; and to provide for compensation and
distribution.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. This act shall apply only to Cullman 9 County.

Section 2. On and after the effective date of this 10 11 act, any municipality within Cullman County may contract for 12 police services with the sheriff of the county. The contract 13 may include the enforcement by the sheriff and his or her duly 14 commissioned deputies of all laws within the corporate limits 15 and police jurisdiction of the municipality including 16 municipal ordinances and the arrest or citation of any 17 offenders as if the sheriff and his or her deputies were duly 18 constituted police officers of the municipality.

19 Section 3. A municipality entering into a contract 20 with the sheriff for police services shall pay to the county 21 treasury a sum sufficient to provide the necessary manpower 22 and equipment as mutually agreed upon by the municipal 23 governing body, the sheriff of the county, and the county 24 commission. Section 4. The county governing body may receive from the municipality within the county money for police services and may expend funds for police services in the contracting municipality, including the police jurisdiction of the municipality.

6 Section 5. Each contract between the county 7 governing body and the contracting municipality shall be with 8 the consent and approval of the sheriff and the county 9 commission.

10 Section 6. The sheriff and his or her duly 11 commissioned deputies shall retain the legal and 12 constitutional immunity afforded to each of them by law.

Section 7. All laws or parts of laws which conflictwith this act are repealed.

15 Section 8. The provisions of this act are severable. 16 If any part of this act is declared invalid or 17 unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part 18 which remains.

Section 9. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
