1 "(3) All employees of the city board of education 2 engaged in the profession of teaching or in supervising teaching in the public schools. 3 4 "(4) Attorneys, physicians, surgeons, nurses, and dentists employed in their professional capacities. 5 "(5) The judge of any court. 6 7 "(6) Independent contractors receiving their remuneration from public funds under contracts awarded by 8 competitive bidding. 9 10 "(7) Any person whose employment is subject to the 11 approval of the United States government or any of its 12 agencies. "(8) The secretary of the chief executive officer of 13 14 the city. 15 "(9) Any employees at a hospital or nursing home, whether operated by the city or by any municipal authority or 16 17 board of the city. "(10) Any professional librarian employed by the 18 city." 19 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 20 21 first day of the third month following its passage and 22 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
