21	remove the prohibition on electing or appointing members of
22	the Public Service Commission from the same congressional

24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
25	Section 1. Section 37-1-3 of the Code of Alabama
26	1975, is amended to read as follows:
27	"\$37-1-3.

"(a) The terms of office of the commissioners shall 1 2 be for four years; at the election to be held in the state on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 1940, 3 4 and every four years thereafter, a president of said commission shall be elected by the qualified electors of this 5 6 state; and at the election to be held in the state on the 7 first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 1942, and every four years thereafter, two associates, who, with the 8 president, shall constitute said commission, shall be elected 9 10 by the qualified electors of the state. The result of such election shall be ascertained and declared by the same 11 12 authority and in the same manner as are the results of 13 election for chief justice and associate justices of the 14 supreme court.

15 "(b) The persons elected to fill said offices shall 16 enter upon the discharge of their respective duties on the day 17 after the general election at which they are elected and 18 expire on the day after the general election held in the 19 fourth year after their election.

"(c) If any vacancy should occur in any one of said 20 21 offices, caused by death, resignation or otherwise, the same 22 shall be filled by appointment by the Governor, the appointee 23 holding for the balance of the unexpired term. If any person 24 elected to the office of public service commissioner shall fail or refuse for 30 days to qualify, such failure or refusal 25 26 shall be held to create a vacancy in the office, which vacancy 27 shall be filled by appointment by the Governor, the appointee

1 to hold for the term for which the person so failing or 2 refusing to qualify was elected.

3 " (d) No two of said public service commissioners
4 shall be elected or appointed from the same congressional
5 district. But this section shall not disqualify or render
6 ineligible for election or appointment any person holding such
7 office on the date of enactment or effective date of any law
8 redistricting the state for election of representatives in
9 Congress.

10 "(e)(d) The provisions of this section shall not 11 diminish the current term of any member elected to the Public 12 Service Commission."

Section 2. This act shall become effective
immediately following its passage and approval by the
Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
