1 The gross receipts or gross proceeds of any guided 2 rafting trip on the Chattahoochee River, including any 3 receipts or proceeds allocable to services provided by a 4 guide, food and equipment for a trip, transportation to and 5 from the river, and related goods, activities, and services, 6 shall be exempt from all state, county, and municipal sales, 7 use, and lease or rental taxes.

8 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict9 with this act are repealed.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
