"(a) Judgments for the payment of money, other than 2 costs, if based upon a contract action, bear interest from the 3 4 day of the cause of action, at the same rate of interest as 5 stated in the contract; all other judgments shall bear interest from the day of the cause of action at the rate of 6 7 7.5 percent per annum, the provisions of Section 8-8-1 to the contrary notwithstanding; provided, that fees allowed a 8 trustee, executor, administrator, or attorney and taxed as a 9 10 part of the cost of the proceeding shall bear interest at a 11 like rate from the day of entry.

"(b) This section shall apply to all judgmentsentered on and after September 1, 2011."

14 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 15 first day of the third month following its passage and 16 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
