TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines and corporate limits of the municipality of Lake View in Tuscaloosa County; to add certain property to the municipality of Lake View; to make certain findings in regard to the public necessity for the annexation; and to provide that the municipality shall exercise full authority over the annexed territory.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
Section 1. The Legislature hereby finds and determines that it is expedient, wise, necessary, proper, and in the best interests of the citizens of the State of Alabama, Tuscaloosa County, and the municipality of Lake View to alter, rearrange, and extend the corporate limits of the municipality of Lake View as herein provided, including, but not limited to, the purpose of generally promoting the welfare of the

State of Alabama, Tuscaloosa County, and the municipality of Lake View and specifically, but not limited to, the initial purpose of facilitating the municipality of Lake View in providing certain services to the area to be annexed. Provided, however, the foregoing shall not be construed to limit in any manner or otherwise curtail the exercise of any municipal powers and authorities by the municipality of Lake View and shall not prohibit future or subsequent annexations in accordance with the provisions hereof and the laws of the state.

Section 2. The boundary lines and corporate limits of the municipality of Lake View in Tuscaloosa County are altered, rearranged, extended, and redefined to include within the corporate limits of the municipality, in addition to the lands now included, all of the territory below described in Tuscaloosa County, Alabama:

PARCEL ONE (Petro) - Begin at the NE corner of the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 20, Township 20 South, Range 5 19 West, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, and run in a Southerly direction along the East line of said 1/4 - 1/4 Section a distance of 1253.08 feet (1253.61' deed) to a point; thence deflect 60 degrees 58' 54" (61 degrees 01' deed) to the right and run in a Southwesterly direction a distance of 914.24 feet to a point; thence deflect 23 degrees 27 ' to the right and run in a Southwesterly direction a distance of 7.60 feet to a point on the North Right-of-Way line of Old Tuscaloosa Highway; thence deflect 13 degrees $04^{\prime}$ to the right and run in
a Northwesterly direction a distance of 206.83 feet along said right-of-way to a point on the right-of-way acquired for Interstate 59; thence deflect 2 degrees 02' 30 " to the right and run in a Northwesterly direction along said Interstate 59 a distance of 411.38 feet to a point; thence deflect 90 degrees 48' to the right and run in a Northeasterly direction along said Interstate 59 right-of-way a distance of 60.05 feet to a point; thence deflect 87 degrees $45^{\prime}$ to the left and run in a Northwesterly direction a distance of 292.40 feet along the right-of-way of Interstate 59 to a point; thence deflect 46 degrees 25' 45" to the right and run in a Northwesterly direction a distance of 128.50 feet along the right-of-way of Interstate 59 to a point; thence deflect 55 degrees 57' 30" to the right and run in a Northeasterly direction a distance of 697.10 feet along the right-of-way of Interstate 59 to a point; thence deflect 8 degrees $33^{\prime}$ 30" to the right and run in a Northeasterly direction a distance of 205.20 feet along the right-of-way of Interstate 59 to a point; thence deflect 11 degrees $44^{\prime}$ to the right and run in a Northeasterly direction a distance of 131.88 feet along the right-of-way of Interstate 59 to the point of beginning of a curve to the right having a central angle of 5 degrees $28^{\prime}$ 51" and a radius of 7489.49 feet, and an arc of 716.42 feet; thence continue in a Northeasterly direction along the arc of said curve and along said Interstate 59 right-of-way a distance of 716.4 feet, more or less, to a point of intersection of said right-of-way curve with the North line of said 1/4 - 1/4

Section; thence deflect 39 degrees 42' 09" to the right from the tangent of last described curve and run along the North line of said 1/4-1/4 Section in an Easterly direction a distance of 724.90 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning; said parcel containing 49.56 acres (+-).

PARCEL TWO (Loves-1). A parcel of land situated in the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 19, Township 20 South, Range West, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows: Commence at a 3" iron pipe at the SW corner of the SE $1 / 4$ of Section 19, Township 20 South, Range 1 West, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama; thence run North 00 degrees 46' 34" West along the West boundary of the $S E 1 / 4$ of said Section 19 a distance of 1296.02 feet to a point of the South right-of-way of Alabama Hwy. No. 216 (variable right-of-way); thence, run South 79 degrees 41' 42" East along said right-of-way a distance of 295.93 feet to a 1/2" rebar and cap set at the point of curvature of a curve concave Northwardly, said curve having a radius of 7551.00 feet and a delta angle left of 02 degrees 48' 38"; thence, run along said curve an arc distance of 370.41 feet to a point (the chord subtending said arc bearing South 81 degrees 06' 01 " East a distance of 370.38 feet) to the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence, continue along said curving right-of-way an arc distance of 51.68 feet to a 1/2" rebar and cap set at the point of tangency of said curve (the curve subtending said arc bearing South 82 degrees 42' 06" East a distance of 51.68 feet); thence, run South 82 degrees 53' 52" East along said right-of-way a distance of
247.39 feet to a 1/2" rebar and cap set at the intersection of the South right-of-way of said Alabama Hwy. No. 216 and the Northwest right-of-way of U.S.Interstate $20 / 59$ (variable right-of-way); thence, run South 28 degrees $25^{\prime} 01 "$ West along the Northwest right-of-way of said Interstate Highway a distance of 578.38 feet to a concrete right-of-way monument found at centerline Station $112+21.64$; thence, run South 39 degrees 51' 06" West along said right-of-way a distance of 19.64 feet to an iron bar found; thence, depart said right-of-way and run North 00 degrees 54' 42" West a distance of 560.99 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; said parcel containing 1.9 acres (+-).

PARCEL THREE (Loves-2) A parcel of land situated in the $\operatorname{SW} 1 / 4$ of the $\operatorname{SE} 1 / 4$ of Section 19, Township 20 South, Range 1 West, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, more particularly described as follows: Commence in a $3^{\prime \prime}$ iron pipe at the SW corner of the SE $1 / 4$ of Section 19, Township 20 South, Range 1 West, Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, thence run North 00 degrees 46' 34" West along the West boundary of the SE $1 / 4$ of said Section 19 a distance of 1296.02 feet to a point on the South right-of-way of Alabama Hwy. No. 216 (variable right-of-way); thence, run South 79 degrees 41' 42" East along said right-of-way a distance of 191.21 feet to a 1/2" rebar and cap set at the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence, continue South 79 degrees 41' 42" East along said right-of-way a distance of 104.72 feet to a 1/2" rebar and cap set at the Point of Curvature of a curve concave Northwardly, said curve having a
radius of 7551.00 feet and a Delta angle left of 0223 degrees 48' 38"; thence run along said curve an arc distance of 370.41 feet to a point (the curve subtending said arc bearing South 81 degrees 06' 01" East a distance of 370.38 feet); thence, depart said right-of-way, run South 00 degrees 54' 42" East a distance of 373.99 feet to a 1/2" rebar and cap set; thence, run South 89 degrees $05^{\prime} 18^{\prime \prime}$ West a distance of 474.73 feet to a 1/2" rebar and cap set; thence run North 00 degrees 01' 47" West a distance of 457.53 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; said parcel containing 4.47 acres.

Section 3. All territory brought within the corporate limits of the municipality of Lake View under the provisions of this act shall be subject to the laws and ordinances of the municipality, and the mayor and council shall have and exercise the same and exclusive jurisdiction over the territory as is presently exercised over the territory within the corporate limits of the municipality.

Section 4. The provisions of this act are severable. If any part of this act is declared invalid or unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part which remains.

Section 5. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.

Section 6. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is proposed to be annexed to the municipality of Lake View is on file in the office of the Judge of Probate in Tuscaloosa

County, Alabama, and the map is open to the inspection of the public.

Section 7. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
