7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Any person employed as a law enforcement 9 officer by the Sheriff's Office of Cherokee County for a 10 period of 10 years or more who retires from the office in good 11 standing may receive from the office, without cost, a retired 12 badge, a retired commission card, and his or her service 13 pistol, provided the pistol is furnished by the office.

Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.
