ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Morgan County; to provide that the Morgan County Deputy License Inspector has the same power and authority as deputy sheriffs and other law enforcement officers in this state if the inspector satisfies certain certification and eligibility requirements.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. In addition to any duties and powers provided to the Morgan County License Inspector in Act 1978-528, 1978 Regular Session (1978 Acts, p. 582), the deputy license inspector shall have the same power and authority as deputy sheriffs and other law enforcement officers in this state if the inspector meets the minimum standards for law enforcement officers and holds a current certification from the Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and Training Commission. The deputy license inspector shall have access to records of the Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center in the same manner as other law enforcement officers.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
