13	Relating to construction of athletic facilities at
14	public schools in Talladega County; to exempt from certain
15	competitive bidding and construction laws, the construction or
16	renovation of a minor athletic facility at a public school in
17	Talladega County, as long as construction is done in
18	compliance with all codes, laws, rules, and standards that
19	apply to persons licensed by the Alabama Home Builders
20	Licensure Board; and to define minor athletic facility.
21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
22	Section 1. This act shall apply only in Talladega
23	County.
24	Section 2. The Legislature of the State of Alabama
25	finds that our citizens strongly support our schools and
26	sports, and that many of our citizens are highly skilled and
27	are willing to donate their time and to donate materials to

1 construct or renovate facilities for school sports. The 2 Legislature further finds that minor athletic facilities, as provided in this act, with a great savings in cost, may be 3 4 adequately and safely constructed and safely used if constructed or renovated by persons or entities that comply 5 6 with or engage persons or entities that comply with the codes, 7 laws, regulations, ordinances, rules, and standards that apply to a person or entity licensed by the Alabama Home Builders 8 Licensure Board without compliance with any other law, code, 9 10 regulation, ordinance, rule, or standard generally required of public school construction projects. 11

Section 3. As used in this act, the following termsshall have the following meanings:

14 (1) MINOR ATHLETIC FACILITY. A concession stand, 15 dugout, changing room, bathroom, or similar facility in the immediate vicinity of a school softball field, baseball field, 16 17 football field, soccer field, track, or other outside school area used for athletic events, practice, or exercise, the 18 total cost of the construction or renovation of which, not 19 including any amount for volunteer labor or services or 20 21 materials donated, is one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) 22 or less.

(2) SCHOOL. A public school, including an elementary
school, middle school, high school, school in which education
for kindergarten through twelfth grade or any of those grades
is provided, community college, college, or university.

1 Section 4. Notwithstanding any provision of the Code 2 of Alabama 1975, or any code, regulation, ordinance, rule, or standard adopted thereto to the contrary, a minor athletic 3 4 facility may be constructed or renovated by a person or entity that complies with, or that engages persons or entities that 5 comply with, all laws, codes, regulations, ordinances, rules, 6 7 and standards that apply at the location of the construction or renovation to a person or entity licensed by the Alabama 8 Home Builders Licensure Board. 9

10 Section 5. This act shall become effective 11 immediately following its passage and approval by the 12 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
