appropriation in fiscal year ending September 30, 2026 from

the State General Fund of any amount not repaid.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the Legislature shall provide for the repayment of all funds transferred from the Alabama Trust Fund to the State General Fund pursuant to Amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901 within ten (10) years following the fiscal year ending September 30, 2015. In the event that full repayment has not been made by September 30, 2025, an appropriation of any amount not repaid shall be made from the State General Fund in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026.

Section 2. All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
