24	Section 1. Section 40-7-60, Code of Alabama 1975, is

"It shall be the function, duty, and responsibility 1 2 of the Department of Revenue to periodically inspect and supervise the implementation and program of reappraisal of all 3 4 property in the State of Alabama and to regulate, according to a definite schedule, the individual county-by-county 5 6 reappraisal of such property. Notwithstanding the foregoing, 7 the individual county-by-county reappraisal shall not be conducted more often than every four tax years." 8 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 9 10 first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law. 11
