4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

5 Section 1. Section 13A-5-9.1, Code of Alabama 1975,
6 is repealed.

Section 2. This act shall be applied prospectively only. Any case, on the effective date of this act, in which a motion filed pursuant to Section 13A-5-9.1, Code of Alabama 1975, is pending in the trial court or is subject to an appeal or pending in an appellate court on appeal from the denial of a motion shall not be affected by this act.

Section 3. This act shall become effective
immediately following its passage and approval by the
Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
