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4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 To amend Section 32-6-68 of the Code of Alabama  
6 1975, providing for an additional fee for the issuance of  
7 distinctive license plates, to further provide for the  
8 distribution of the fee to the Department of Senior Services  
9 for meals for seniors.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. Section 32-6-68 of the Code of Alabama  
12 1975, is amended to read as follows:

13 "§32-6-68.

14 "(a) Effective January 1, 1997, each new distinctive  
15 license plate issued shall require, in addition to the  
16 standard registration fee, an additional annual fee of fifty  
17 dollars (\$50).

18 "(b) The additional license plate fee as provided  
19 for in subsection (a) shall be distributed in the following  
20 manner:

21 "(1) Two and one-half percent commission, provided  
22 by Section 40-12-269(a)(1).

23 "(2) Manufacturing costs of one dollar and fifty  
24 cents (\$1.50) to the Department of Corrections.

1           "(3) Administrative costs of one dollar (\$1) to the  
2 Department of Revenue.

3           "~~State shares~~ A state share of five dollars (\$5)  
4 shall be transmitted to the state Comptroller for deposit ~~into~~  
5 ~~the Penny Trust Fund as established by Amendment 512 of the~~  
6 ~~Constitution of Alabama of 1901~~ in an account maintained by  
7 the Department of Senior Services to be used by the department  
8 to provide meals to senior citizens under a program to be  
9 known as the "John L. Buskey Senior Meals Program." Funds  
10 deposited in the account are continuously appropriated to the  
11 department for the purpose of this subdivision.

12           "(5) The remainder of the additional fee shall be  
13 distributed to the sponsoring organization or as otherwise  
14 provided under the terms of the application approved by the  
15 legislative oversight committee.

16           "(c) The distribution of fees for tags which were  
17 authorized by legislative act before January 1, 1998, shall  
18 continue in effect, any other provision of law to the contrary  
19 notwithstanding."

20           Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
21 first day of the third month following its passage and  
22 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
