Section 32-6-68 of the Code of Alabama 12 1975, is amended to read as follows: 13 "§32-6-68. "(a) Effective January 1, 1997, each new distinctive 14 license plate issued shall require, in addition to the 15 16 standard registration fee, an additional annual fee of fifty 17 dollars (\$50). 18 "(b) The additional license plate fee as provided 19 for in subsection (a) shall be distributed in the following 20 manner: "(1) Two and one-half percent commission, provided 21 22 by Section 40-12-269(a)(1). 23 "(2) Manufacturing costs of one dollar and fifty 24 cents (\$1.50) to the Department of Corrections.

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"(3) Administrative costs of one dollar (\$1) to the
Department of Revenue.

3 "(4) State shares A state share of five dollars (\$5) shall be transmitted to the state Comptroller for deposit into 4 5 the Penny Trust Fund as established by Amendment 512 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901 in an account maintained by 6 7 the Department of Senior Services to be used by the department 8 to provide meals to senior citizens under a program to be known as the "John L. Buskey Senior Meals Program." Funds 9 10 deposited in the account are continuously appropriated to the 11 department for the purpose of this subdivision.

"(5) The remainder of the additional fee shall be distributed to the sponsoring organization or as otherwise provided under the terms of the application approved by the legislative oversight committee.

16 "(c) The distribution of fees for tags which were 17 authorized by legislative act before January 1, 1998, shall 18 continue in effect, any other provision of law to the contrary 19 notwithstanding."

20 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 21 first day of the third month following its passage and 22 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
