1 majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in 2 accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution 3 of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

5 After the effective date of this amendment, no 6 business license tax may be imposed on the rental of 7 residential real estate on a per unit basis by a county or 8 municipality unless the tax was imposed prior to January 1, 9 2013.

10 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 11 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 12 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 13 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 14 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 15 state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to prohibit the imposition of a business license tax by a county or a municipality on the rental of residential real estate on a per unit basis unless the tax was imposed before January 1, 2013.
