accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution 1 of Alabama of 1901, as amended: 2 PROPOSED AMENDMENT 3 In order to preserve the freedom of all residents of Alabama to provide for their own post-minority education, no 5 6 law, rule, or court order shall compel, either directly or 7 indirectly, any person to provide financial support of another legal adult over the age of 19 for his or her post-minority 8 9 education. 10 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 11 12 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 13 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 14 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 15 state. 16 Section 3.
