## PROPOSED AMENDMENT

9 The Legislature by local law applicable to Mobile 10 County may provide for the levy of an additional ad valorem 11 tax not to exceed one mill on all real property in the 12 unincorporated area of the county included in county 13 commission district one on the date of the ratification of 14 this amendment to be distributed to qualified volunteer fire 15 departments as provided in the local law.

16 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 17 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the 18 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 19 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 20 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 21 state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment: "Relating to Mobile County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to authorize the Legislature by local law to levy an additional ad valorem tax on real property in the unincorporated area of the county included in county commission district one on the date of the ratification of this amendment to be distributed to qualified volunteer fire departments.
