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6 ENROLLED, An Act,

7 Relating to the City of Weaver; authorizing the sale  
8 of alcoholic beverages within the city limits each day of the  
9 week by properly licensed clubs and retail licensees of the  
10 Alcoholic Beverage Control Board and to provide for the  
11 off-premises sale of alcoholic beverages; and to authorize the  
12 governing body of the city to regulate the selling of  
13 alcoholic beverages to the general public by properly licensed  
14 retailers.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

16 Section 1. This act only applies to the City of  
17 Weaver and provides for the City of Weaver Ecotourism Beverage  
18 Bill.

19 Section 2. Alcoholic beverages may be sold each day  
20 of the week for on-premises consumption by licensed clubs and  
21 retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board in  
22 the City of Weaver if approved by a majority vote of the  
23 governing body.

24 Section 3. Alcoholic beverages may be sold each day  
25 of the week for off-premises consumption by licensed clubs and

1 retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board  
2 within the City of Weaver if approved by a majority vote of  
3 the governing body.

4 Section 4. The governing body of the City of Weaver,  
5 by resolution or ordinance passed by a simple majority, may  
6 regulate, but may not prohibit, the sale of both on-premises  
7 and off-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages each day  
8 of the week by licensed clubs and retail licensees of the  
9 Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to the general public.  
10 Licensed clubs and retail licensees granted a license may sell  
11 or dispense alcoholic beverages pursuant to the requirements  
12 of the license and applicable regulations of the board.

13 Section 5. The provisions of this act are cumulative  
14 and supplemental to the present power and authority of the  
15 City of Weaver and are not intended to, nor shall it be  
16 interpreted so as to, repeal any existing power or authority  
17 of the governing body with this act that are now permitted  
18 under the general laws of the state or under any local or  
19 special act of the Legislature.

20 Section 6. This act shall become effective  
21 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
22 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
