- (c) The Lee County Commission may receive rebates from any procurement card program. Any rebates shall be deposited in the Lee County General Fund to be used first to reimburse the county for any costs related to the operation of the supplemental purchasing process and thereafter for general county purposes.
- (d) This act is enacted pursuant to the authority of the county commission to direct, control, and manage the property of the county pursuant to subdivision (1) of Section 11-3-11, Code of Alabama 1975.
- (e) This act shall not affect the requirement that any purchase be purchased pursuant to a competitive bid when required by general law.
- Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
