7 Relating to Clay County; to amend Section  
8 45-14-80.03 relating to court costs; to provide that a  
9 municipality in Clay County may assess a fee on any case filed  
10 in the municipal court; and to provide that the municipal  
11 court fee would be retained by the municipality where  
12 collected.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

14 Section 1. Section 45-14-80.03, Code of Alabama  
15 1975, is amended to read as follows:

16 "§45-14-80.03.

17 "(a) In addition to any court costs and fees now or  
18 hereafter authorized in Clay County, the Clay County  
19 Commission may impose by resolution of the commission an  
20 additional fee in an amount not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50)  
21 to be assessed and taxed as costs on each civil case and on  
22 each criminal case, including traffic cases, filed in the  
23 circuit court, or district court, ~~or any municipal court~~ in  
24 Clay County. These fees shall not be waived by any court

1 unless all other fees, assessments, costs, fines, and charges  
2 associated with the case are waived.

3 (b) In addition to any court costs and fees now or  
4 hereafter authorized in Clay County, the governing body of any  
5 municipality in Clay County may impose by resolution of the  
6 governing body an additional fee in an amount not to exceed  
7 fifty dollars (\$50) to be assessed and taxed as costs on each  
8 civil case and on each criminal case, including traffic cases,  
9 filed in the municipal court. These fees shall not be waived  
10 by any court unless all other fees, assessments, costs, fines,  
11 and charges associated with the case are waived.

12 ~~"(b)~~ (c) When collected by the clerk of the district  
13 or circuit court or his or her court collection officers, the  
14 additional fees shall be paid into the General Fund of Clay  
15 County. When collected by the municipal court, the additional  
16 fees shall be paid to the general fund of the municipality  
17 where collected."

18 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
19 first day of the third month following its passage and  
20 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
