An election upon the proposed amendment 11 shall be held at the next statewide primary, general or 12 special election in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of 13 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 14 284 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution 15 of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 16 state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to authorize the legislature to provide a retirement program for district attorneys and circuit clerks of the state who are first elected or appointed on or after November 4, 2014."
