6 ENROLLED, An Act,

7 Relating to Baldwin County; to amend Section  
8 45-2-80.60, Code of Alabama 1975, to increase the amount of  
9 additional court costs assessed and collected from persons  
10 incarcerated in the county jail.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. Section 45-2-80.60, Code of Alabama 1975,  
13 is amended to read as follows:

14 "§45-2-80.60.

15 "(a) In Baldwin County, additional court costs in  
16 the amount of five up to twenty dollars ~~(\$5)~~ (\$20) per day to  
17 be set by the sheriff shall be assessed and collected against  
18 each person incarcerated ~~or booked~~ in the Baldwin County jail.  
19 The court costs assessed pursuant to this section shall be in  
20 addition to any other court costs or other costs and charges  
21 imposed on persons incarcerated ~~or booked~~ in the Baldwin  
22 County jail not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

23 "(b) The court costs imposed by this section shall  
24 be assessed against a defendant upon conviction, violation of  
25 probation, or order of commitment, by the appropriate court

1 ~~where the defendant is convicted~~ having jurisdiction. The  
2 sheriff shall notify the appropriate court on a regular basis  
3 of the exact amount of the assessment for entry on the docket  
4 sheet.

5 "(c) The revenues derived from the fees shall be  
6 credited on a monthly basis to a Law Enforcement Fund  
7 established by Part 3 of Article 23 to be used by the Sheriff  
8 of Baldwin County for the operation of the office of the  
9 sheriff including, but not limited to, office equipment,  
10 communication equipment, salary supplements, expense  
11 allowances, training, the operation of the Baldwin County  
12 jail, and other expenses for the enhancement of law  
13 enforcement in the county.

14 "(d) In any case where the fees provided by this  
15 section are not paid, the district attorney of the county  
16 shall assist in the collection of the fees in the same manner  
17 as other court ordered monies and shall be entitled to the  
18 same fees.

19 "(e) Any revenues derived from this section shall be  
20 in addition to any other funding for the operation of the  
21 sheriff's office and shall not reduce any funding from any  
22 other source."

23 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
24 first day of the third month following its passage and  
25 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
