2 Relating to alcoholic beverages; to prohibit the issuance of a license to sell or serve alcoholic beverages to 3 a facility where gambling or the game of bingo is played using electronic machines; and to provide that as of the date of 5 6 this bill's approval by the Governor, or its otherwise 7 becoming law, each license to sell or serve alcoholic beverages currently issued to a facility where gambling or the 8 game of bingo is played using electronic machines shall be 9 10 considered null and void and of no effect as of the date that 11 this act becomes law.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of law, a license to sell or serve alcoholic beverages may not be issued or renewed by a person or other entity where any of the following activities occur:

- (1) Gambling as that term is defined in Section 13A-12-20, Code of Alabama 1975.
- (2) Class II gaming or Class III gaming as those terms are defined in 25 U.S.C. §2703.
- (b) Each license to sell or serve alcoholic beverages currently issued to a person or entity where considered null and void and of no effect as of the date that this act becomes law.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
