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8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the Foundation for Local
9 Schools was created by legislative act as a public
10 corporation to accept and invest private donations
11 for the enhancement of public K-12 schools.

12 Also, existing law requires, upon
13 dissolution of the foundation, for monies in the
14 accounts of various school systems to be disbursed
15 to local school systems and monies remaining in
16 various participating trusts to be returned in
17 whole to the treasurer of each applicable trust
18 fund.

19 This bill would dissolve the foundation and
20 provide for the disbursement of the funds held in
21 the accounts of the foundation.

24 TO BE ENTITLED
25 AN ACT
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1 Relating to the Foundation for Local Schools; to
2 provide for the dissolution of the foundation and the
3 disbursement of funds held in the accounts of the foundation;
4 and to repeal Chapter 26C, consisting of Sections 16-26C-1 to
5 16-26C-13, Title 16, Code of Alabama 1975.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. On or before September 30, 2013, the
8 State Superintendent of Education and the Chief Executive
9 Officer of the Teachers' Retirement System shall take the
10 actions necessary to provide for the dissolution of the
11 Foundation for Local Schools and the disbursement of assets
12 held in the accounts of the Foundation for Local Schools
13 pursuant to this act and Section 16-26C-13, Code of Alabama
14 1975.

15 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
16 with this act are repealed. Specifically, Chapter 26C,
17 consisting of Sections 16-26C-1 to 16-26C-13, of Title 16,
18 Code of Alabama 1975, relating to the Foundation for Local
19 Schools, is repealed.

20 Section 3. This act shall become effective
21 immediately following its passage and approval by the
22 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
