1           "(3) The sheriff and district attorney of the county  
2 where the escape occurred.

3           "(4) The chief of police where the escape occurred,  
4 if the escape occurred within a municipality.

5           "(5) The sheriff and district attorney of the county  
6 where the last conviction of the escapee occurred.

7           "(6) The chief of police where the last conviction  
8 of the escapee occurred, if the conviction occurred within a  
9 municipality.

10           "(7) The sheriff of the county where the convict's  
11 home of record is located.

12           "(8) The chief of police where the convict's home of  
13 record is located, if the location is within a municipality.

14           "(9) All electronic media outlets broadcasting from  
15 within a radius of 75 miles from where the escape occurred,  
16 including all radio and television stations.

17           "(c) The notification required in subsection (b)  
18 shall include the time when and the circumstances under which  
19 it the escape was effected, together with a particular  
20 description of the ~~convict~~ inmate, including a copy of the  
21 inmate's most recent mug shot, and in what county convicted  
22 and for what offense and when.

23           "(d) In addition to the requirements set forth in  
24 subsections (b) and (c), the department shall post a  
25 notification on its website of the escape. The notification  
26 shall include the time when and the circumstances under which  
27 the escape was effected, together with a particular

1 description of the inmate, including a copy of the inmate's  
2 most recent mug shot, and in what county convicted and for  
3 what offense and when.

4 "(e) The Director of Central Records, or his or her  
5 designee, of the department shall enter the inmate into the  
6 National Crime Information Center within 12 hours of the  
7 inmate's escape.

8 "(f) The Department of Corrections and the board  
9 shall offer a reward, not exceeding \$400.00 four hundred  
10 dollars (\$400), for the apprehension of ~~such~~ the state  
11 convict, to be paid out of the proceeds of the labor of  
12 ~~convicts~~ inmates in the State Treasury. But no warrant shall  
13 be issued for the payment of any such reward unless there is  
14 filed in the office of the Department of Finance the  
15 certificate of the ~~board~~ Department of Corrections that ~~such~~  
16 ~~convict~~ the inmate has been recaptured and restored to  
17 custody."

18 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
19 first day of the third month following its passage and  
20 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
