1 shall be elected at the same election for a four-year term of 2 office.

3 "(c) Commencing with the municipal election in 2013, 4 and thereafter, the mayor shall serve no more than two 5 consecutive full terms of office." 6 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 7 first day of the third month following its passage and

approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
