5	residency, to also classify certain members of the Alabama

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
9	Section 1. Section 16-64-2 of the Code of Alabama
10	1975, is amended to read as follows:
11	"§16-64-2.
12	"For purposes of admission and tuition, a public
13	institution of higher education may consider that the term
14	resident student includes any of the following:
15	"(1) One who, at the time of registration, is not a
16	minor and satisfies one of the following:
17	"a. Is a full-time permanent employee of the
18	institution at which the student is registering or is the
19	spouse of such an employee.
20	"b. Can verify full-time permanent employment within
21	the State of Alabama or is the spouse of such an employee and

1	"c. Is a member or the spouse of a member of the		
2	United States military on full-time active duty stationed in		
3	Alabama under orders for duties other than attending school.		
4	"d. Is employed as a graduate assistant or fellow by

6	"e. Is an accredited member of or the spouse of an		
7	accredited member of a consular staff assigned to duties in		
8	Alabama.		
9	"f. Is, at the time of passage of this chapter, a		
10	student enrolled at a public college or university and who is		
11	currently classified as a resident for tuition purposes		
12	provided such student maintains continuous enrollment at that		
13	institution.		
14	"g. Commencing on the effective date of the act		
15	adding this paragraph, is a member of the Alabama National		
16	Guard. adding this paragraph, has been a member of the Alabama		
17	National Guard for a period of at least two years immediately		
18	preceding the student qualifying for resident tuition and		
19	continues to be a member of the Alabama National Guard while		
20	enrolled at the public institution of higher education.		
21	"(2) One who, at the time of registration, is a		
22	minor and whose supporting person satisfies one of the		
23	following:		
24	"a. Is a full-time permanent employee of the		

institution at which the student is registering.

2	the State of Alabama and will commence said employment within
3	90 days of registration with the institution.
4	"c. Is a member of the United States military on
5	full-time active duty stationed in Alabama under orders for
6	duties other than attending school.
7	"d. Is an accredited member of a consular staff
8	assigned to duties in Alabama."
9	Section 2. This act shall become effective
10	immediately following its passage and approval by the
11	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
