13 Relating to DeKalb County; providing for an
14 additional fee for marriage licenses; and providing for the
15 distribution of the proceeds of the fee.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. (a) In addition to all other costs and
18 fees charged for marriage licenses in DeKalb County there
19 shall be assessed an additional fee of twenty dollars (\$20).

20 (b) (1) The judge of probate shall collect the fee.
21 The judge of probate shall retain five dollars (\$5) of each of
22 the fees as an administrative cost. The remaining proceeds
23 shall be collected and maintained by the judge of probate and
24 remitted quarterly to the DeKalb County Commission, which
25 shall place the monies in a designated account in the county
26 treasury earmarked for the DeKalb County Child Advocacy Center
27 to be used for the operation of the center including providing

1 services to the children and families of DeKalb County as well
2 as assistance to DeKalb County law enforcement and the DeKalb
3 County Department of Human Resources.

4 (2) The DeKalb County Child Advocacy Center, before
5 the end of each county fiscal year, shall provide to the
6 DeKalb County Commission a proposed budget showing the use of
7 the monies held by the DeKalb County Commission. The DeKalb
8 County Commission shall remit the funds quarterly to the
9 DeKalb County Child Advocacy Center.

10 Section 2. This act shall become effective
11 immediately following its passage and approval by the
12 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
