(2) The DeKalb County Child Advocacy Center, before the end of each county fiscal year, shall provide to the DeKalb County Commission a proposed budget showing the use of the monies held by the DeKalb County Commission. The DeKalb County Commission shall remit the funds quarterly to the DeKalb County Child Advocacy Center.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
