3 To exempt the Alabama Association of Volunteer Fire 4 Departments, county volunteer fire associations, the Alabama 5 Association of Rescue Squads, Incorporated, all volunteer rescue squads that are members of the Alabama Association of 6 Rescue Squads, all county volunteer rescue associations, all 7 8 local fire districts that are not under the auspices of their county commission from any state, county, and local sales and 9 10 use taxes and ad valorem taxes; provided no tax which has 11 proceeds dedicated to K-12 public education may be exempted. 12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

13 Section 1. The Alabama Association of Volunteer Fire 14 Departments, county volunteer fire associations, the Alabama 15 Association of Rescue Squads, Incorporated, all volunteer 16 rescue squads that are members of the Alabama Association of 17 Rescue Squads, all county volunteer rescue associations, and 18 all local fire districts that are not under the auspices of 19 their county commission are exempt from any state, county, and 20 local sales and use taxes and ad valorem taxes; provided no 21 tax which has proceeds dedicated to K-12 public education may 22 be exempted.

23 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 24 first day of the third month following its passage and 25 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
